Call for papers

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Tartu – Estonia

The submission and review of papers for the Conference Biosystems Engineering will be managed in an online conference management system called EasyChair. This system will make the submission and management process easier for the users and for the editors. Once the abstract or the manuscript are submitted the author can check the code of the submission, update information about the submission and track the review status. As a new user, you will have to register before submitting your abstract or manuscript.

Authors of the accepted abstracts will be invited to submit their full papers (including figures, tables and references) through the platform. The authors will be notified about the successful submission of the manuscript immediately after submission. All papers will be rigorously peer-reviewed by specialists in the specific field before acceptance.




